## **Fields Corner Main Street Committees**

### **Design**

The Design Committee helps to get the Fields Corner business district into top physical condition, keeping in mind historic preservation needs while allowing creativity in developing an attractive and functional district. The committee focuses on storefront rehabilitations and signage, landscape design, public spaces, window displays, streetlights, and parking.

### **Economic Restructuring**

The Economic Restructuring Committee conducts research on the neighborhood economy and monitors the economic performance of the district. The information the committee gathers will help us develop strategies to make existing businesses more profitable and to recruit new businesses.

### **Elder Friendly Business District**

The Elder Friendly Business District Steering Committee works to improve access, services, and infrastructure to encourage older adults to shop in Fields Corner in partnership with area older adults and businesses.

### **Fundraising**

The Fundraising Committee raises money for the organization by identifying and soliciting funds from external sources of support and by organizing fundraising events.

### **Organization**

The Organization Committee works to promote the Fields Corner Main Street organization; to inform people about FCMS' activities; to foster relationships among residents, businesses, and community organizations; to recruit new members; and to recommend candidates for the Board of Directors.

### **Promotion**

The Promotion Committee produces materials and organizes public events to promote the businesses in the neighborhood and to publicize the Fields Corner area as a desirable place to shop, eat, and do business.
